VETEC introduction

The Vietnamese - European Knowledge and Technology Transfer Education Consortium (VETEC) is an EU – funded project in Erasmus + Key Action 2 framework.

The project aims at unlocking the Vietnamese knowledge and technology transfer (KTT) potential by creating leadership and strengthening management and educational capacities in the field of KTT in Vietnamese HEIs. VETEC furthermore aims to improve international KTT capacities of the participating Vietnamese and European universities in the project and to strengthen its cooperation approaches on KTT in EU and Vietnam as well.

VETEC has six partners:

- In EU: Vrije Universiteit Brussel (VUB), Belgium; TU Dresden (TUD), Germany; Aveiro University (AU) - Portugal.
- in Vietnam: Hanoi University of Science and Technology, Hue University, and Can Tho University.

And other associate partners:

VETEC training

During the project lifetime, a total of 18 Technology Transfer Office (TTO) staff members from Vietnamese universities will come for a 2 - month training, nine university leaders will get a two-week leadership training period to EU.

European universities will benefit from the project by developing expertise in KTT in emerging economies. Staff members of the European partners will go to Vietnam for a 3-month training program.
